Mr. George Candel Opens Up-To-The-Minute Hat Shop

Mr. George Candel, who, fourteen years ago, established his well-known Manila Hat Store at No. 59 North Szechuen Road, has just recently opened for the convenience of his many patrons another up-to-the-minute hat shop, the "La Espana" at No. P.510 Nanking Road, which already is proving most popular in meeting the ever-increasing demand for remodelled and individually designed headgear.

An expert himself in the art of hat making, Mr. Candel has devoted his entire attention to personally supervising his workshops, and from time to time has added to his staff of skilled Filipino workers until now there are 11 experts, specially engaged and brought over by him from Manila, busily transforming last season's apparently hopeless fells for both men and women into the latest modes by their special process of cleaning, bleaching and blocking, in which these Manila artisans are known to excel.

Mr. Candel, a man of progressive, pioneer spirit and high business standards, has added in no small measure to the commercial success of Shanghai. It was a far cry from a military career begun as a young man in Spain to that of the millinery trade, for he has the distinction of having served Primo de Rivera, present Dictator of Spain, as aide and secretary during the Philippine Revolution against Spain, but retiring from military life, Mr. Candel established and successfully operated the first theatre in Manila, known as "Teatro Filipino," and soon thereafter opened a second theatre in that city.

Feeling the lure of China, he came to Shanghai and started his first cigar factory, employing 40 Filipinos and 800 Chinese workers. But owing to a breakdown of his health and realizing the need of first-class hat renovating shops, he discontinued cigar manufacturing and established his present business, which he has developed materially from year to year.

Ever alert to the advanced needs of his patrons, Mr. Candel provides in both of his Manila Hat Stores a complete assortment of imported felts in the latest colors, which include rich and silky velours from Austria, swagger sports styles from England, the smartest of new shapes from America, lovely soft fine felts from France and even the popular little berets from Spain now so favored for informal sports wear. For spring there are the latest of silk crocheted styles from Germany and the famous Manila weaves.

A most convenient and satisfactory feature of these shops is that both men and women may select just the type and color of hat desired, have it blocked to the individual headsize and transformed on very short notice into the particular style preferred at attractively low prices—a custom that is now
